Monday: In your experiences in life, have you ever noticed how your attempt to get revenge ends up with you looking like Wile E. Coyote? Do you remember that character from the old Looney Tunes who was always trying to catch the Road Runner but things inevitably back fire on him every. single. time. Trying to get revenge usually ends up hurting you more than the person you are trying to hurt. Not only this, the torment you cause yourself robs you of joy and fills you with un-needed stresses while the one you are "against" lives a happy life making you even MADDER! As we learn to avoid the mistake of revenge this week be in prayer for our heart to allow God to take control of all we are. Lord, guide all my ways and all my thoughts. In Jesus name, amen.

Tuesday: "If a man digs a pit, he will fall into it; if a man rolls a stone, it will roll back on him (Proverbs 26:27)." The Message words this verse as follows: "Malice backfires, spite boomerangs." This weeks example we hope to learn from is found in the book of Esther. We will learn from a man named Haman throughout Esther just how dangerous revenge can be and how much it eats at us. Father, allow the mistakes of Haman to be learned. In Jesus, amen.

Wednesday: The book of Esther is only 10 chapters long. We will focus on parts of the first 7 chapters (where Haman is involved) this coming Sunday. Study up before Sunday on at least chapters 1-7. Read all 10 if you desire and have the time. Notice the anger/hatred/revenge pumping through Haman. Also notice the poise/power/faith of Esther and Mordecai. Make sure you surround yourself with only those who will lift you up and guide you rightly instead of those who plant seeds of evil. O, God, help us. Help lead our lives in a way that lifts and rescues others instead of causing harm. In Jesus, amen.

Thursday: "Vengeance is a passion to get even. It is a hot desire to give back as much pain as someone gives you. The problem with revenge is that it never gets what it wants; it never evens the score. Fairness never comes. The chain reaction set off by every act of vengeance always takes its unhindered course. It ties both the injured and the injurer to an escalator of pain. Both are stuck on the escalator as long as parity is demanded, and the escalator never stops, never lets anyone off."- Philip Yancy. O Lord, my God, when I in awesome wonder consider all the worlds Thy hands have made. I see the stars, I hear the rolling thunder, Thy power through the universe displayed. Allow my soul to sing in the freedom I find in You, O God. I give it all to You. In Jesus, amen.

Friday: In two days we read this story and strive to learn some valuable lessons in hopes of avoiding the mistake of revenge. Let your prayer today be that we learn how revenge does nothing to further Gods kingdom. Pray we learn that we should make every effort to live at peace with everyone. Pray we learn Gods way is good...not evil. Pray also that while the desire for revenge isn't necessarily wrong, taking our own revenge is. Dad, help me overcome my emotions without allowing my emotions to overcoming me. In Jesus, amen.

Saturday: Isn't it ironic that Haman ended up hanging from the gallows he had built for his "enemies"? The most powerful truth we find in this story is the powerful truth of Gods sovereignty. God takes care of His people even when things aren't going as we desire. There is a reason behind even the madness we witness and experience. Remain faithful and remain in HIM knowing God will ALWAYS see you through. Father, teach my heart to let go and let You control all things. I lay my issues before You. Lead me, Lord. In Jesus, amen.
